ITINERARY 4-DAY CRUISE



Day 1

ARRIVAL, LOBOS ISLAND & KICKER ROCK

Saturday

Upon arrival, you will be transferred from the airport to the luxury yacht with assistance from an Ocean Spray representative.

Settle your belongings into your cabin and relax before you meet your fellow mates and crew at the welcome lunch.

After lunch, embark on your first Galapagos adventure! Visit San Cristobal Island, the fifth largest island in the Galapagos, and explore the very terrain that Darwin first landed on back in 1835. On the island, you can visit the many government offices, the Ecuadorian Navy, and you can see the local airport. Later, visit Lobos Island, just a quick hour away from San Cristobal. This is a popular place to spot blue-footed boobies and frigate birds, as they typically nest in the area. Sea lions and marine iguanas are also found here. Lobos Island is a fantastic place to take in the islands, with its incredible views, including the famous Kicker Rock off in the distance. This is the perfect introduction to what lies ahead.



Day 2

SAN CRISTOBAL ISLAND, PITT POINT & WITCH HILL

Sunday

This morning, get ready for Pitt Point! Pitt Point rests on San Cristobal Island and is one of the only islands you can find red-footed boobies, blue-footed boobies, and Nazca boobies all in one place. If you have time, hike to the top of the Pitt Point for fantastic, panoramic views of the surrounding area. In the afternoon, head to Witch Hill. Witch Hill is home to a popular beach, featuring beautiful white sand and turquoise waters.

Snorkel here and spot tropical fish and sea turtles swimming beneath the surface. Even an occasional sea lion might stop by to swim with you. If you take a panga ride (Zodiac ride), you can explore the various crevices in the eroding rocks, exciting for any nature enthusiast.



Day 3

FLOREANA ISLAND, POST OFFICE BAY & CORMORANT POINT

Monday

Floreana Island is on the schedule for today! This island is one of the most interesting islands when it comes to human history. The very first Galapagos resident, an Irishman, lived on Floreana Island. It is also where the first post office was stationed. During your visit here, learn about the Ecuadorian colonization, the mystery of the island's isolation, and the small population that lives there today. Post Office Bay is a favorite amongst many tourists who visit this island. They are known for leaving addressed messages on postcards in the Post Office Bay barrel, to be sent by future visitors - a fun activity for many!

Later, head to Cormorant Point. You can visit two beaches while you're here, and flamingoes can be spotted frolicking in the lagoons looking for shrimp. Then, head to Devil's Crown, a visitor site that is the best for snorkeling. Put on your bathing suit and dive deep underwater, where you can see amazing volcanic structures that have submerged over time. There are also hundreds of colorful fish, and of course the coral reefs. This is an underwater experience you cannot miss!



Day 4

BLACK TURTLE COVE & DEPARTURE

Tuesday

On your last morning in the Galapagos, head to Santa Cruz Island, where you will explore Black Turtle Cove. The shallow inlet of Black Turtle Cove is surrounded by mangroves and has a variety of marine life. If you look underneath the surface of the water, you can watch as black-tip, and white-tip reef sharks swim alongside spotted eagle rays and hammerhead sharks.

After your visit at Black Turtle Cove, your Galapagos journey has come to an end. Transfer to the Baltra Airport to your scheduled departure and have a safe flight!
